Charlotte, NC, May 20: American Broadband Communications announced an agreement to acquire Cameron Communications LLC, an industry leading provider of telephone, video, and internet services, from the William L. Henning, Sr. family. Cameron serves approximately 11,000 access lines, 7,000 video customers, and 7,400 broadband customers in thirteen communities in Southwest and Central Louisiana and Southeast Texas.

Cameron's operations include Cameron Telephone, Elizabeth Telephone and LBH, LLC, which operates a state of the art fiber to the home network in rural areas of southwest Louisiana.
